

**IMMEDIATE PHYSICIAN POSITION OPENING

General: This is a professional position involving the practice of medicine in the Mission College Student Health Services. Duties are performed in accordance with 1) established standards and ethics of medical practice, 2) personal clinical qualifications, and 3) the administrative policies and operational procedures of the Student Health Services. Within this framework, duties are carried out with considerable latitude for independent professional judgment and action. Mission College is a public, 2 year community college (9,000 students), located at 3000 Mission College Blvd., Santa Clara, CA 95054.

Responsibilities:

1. Provide medical oversight for small, college health service (2 -3 RN's)
2. Provide primary medical care for eligible students.
3. Prepare and maintain thorough, accurate medical records which justify diagnosis and treatments.
4. Make appropriate use of laboratory and radiological referral services in clinical decision-making in accordance with standard practice.
5. Seek appropriate consultation for unusual or unresponsive cases while following established referral procedures. Incorporate resultant recommendations into treatment plan.
6. Prescribe medications or other therapy as appropriate.
7. Reasonable adherence to appointment schedule with patient encounter volume.
8. Communicate with and educate patients about their medical condition, follow-up care and preventive measures.
9. Assume related responsibilities as requested by Student Health Services coordinator.

Required Qualifications:

1. MD or DO license
2. License to practice medicine in the State of California
3. Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) registration
4. Possess Medical Liability Insurance
5. At least two years of clinical primary care practice.
6. Board certified in Internal Medicine, Family Practice, or other specialty which would support college health practice .
7. Ability to communicate and relate well with students and employees in an academic environment.
